# A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BOARD OF REGENTS, STATE OF IOWA AND SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION MINNESOTA & IOWA



Providing terms and conditions of employment for professional employees in the tertiary health care bargaining unit at The University of Iowa

July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025

## ARTICLE I. WAGES

#### Section 1. Pay Plans

Minimum pay for classifications identified in Appendix A are provided in Appendix B for 2023-2024 and in Appendix C for 2024-2025.

#### Section 2. 2023-2024 Minimum Salaries

Minimum salaries for each classification in the bargaining unit will increase by 3% effective July 1, 2023.

#### Section 3. 2024-2025 Minimum Salaries

Minimum salaries for each classification in the bargaining unit will increase by 3% effective July 1, 2024.

#### Section 4. 2023-2024 Salaries (Returning Employees)

Effective with the 2023-2024 appointment year (July 1, 2023), each returning bargaining unit employee who was employed on April 30, 2023, as a bargaining unit employee shall receive, in addition to existing base salary, a three percent (3%) increase to be added to the employee's base salary for the appointment year 2023-2024.

#### Section 5. 2024-2025 Salaries (Returning Employees)

Effective with the 2024-2025 appointment year (July 1, 2024), each returning bargaining unit employee who was employed on April 30, 2024, as a bargaining unit employee shall receive, in addition to existing base salary, a three percent (3%) increase to be added to the employee's base salary for the appointment year 2024-2025.

#### Section 6. Part-time Employees

Part-time employees, who are members of the bargaining unit, shall receive proportionate increases for each contract year as provided in Section 4 and Section 5 for full-time employees.

#### ARTICLE II. DURATION

#### Section 1. Term

This agreement shall remain in full force and effect for a period of two (2) years from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025.

#### Section 2. Signature

In witness whereof the parties hereto have caused the Agreement to be signed by their respective representatives and their signatures placed thereon.
